Co-operative housing is a people-centred approach where housing is designed and developed for specific needs and outcomes that build stronger communities and ensures choice and control in the housing market.

Co-operative housing can deliver a range a housing that provides for the needs of the community at different stages of life and caters for diverse household types.

Co-operative housing encourages innovation in housing design with a focus on planning for vibrant communities, environmental sustainability and the productive use of shared spaces.

Co-operative housing is especially effective for vulnerable groups eg: seniors, people living with disabilities, key workers, low income earners, vulnerable groups, homeless people, ethnic groups and maximises the economic and social benefits possible through housing development.
